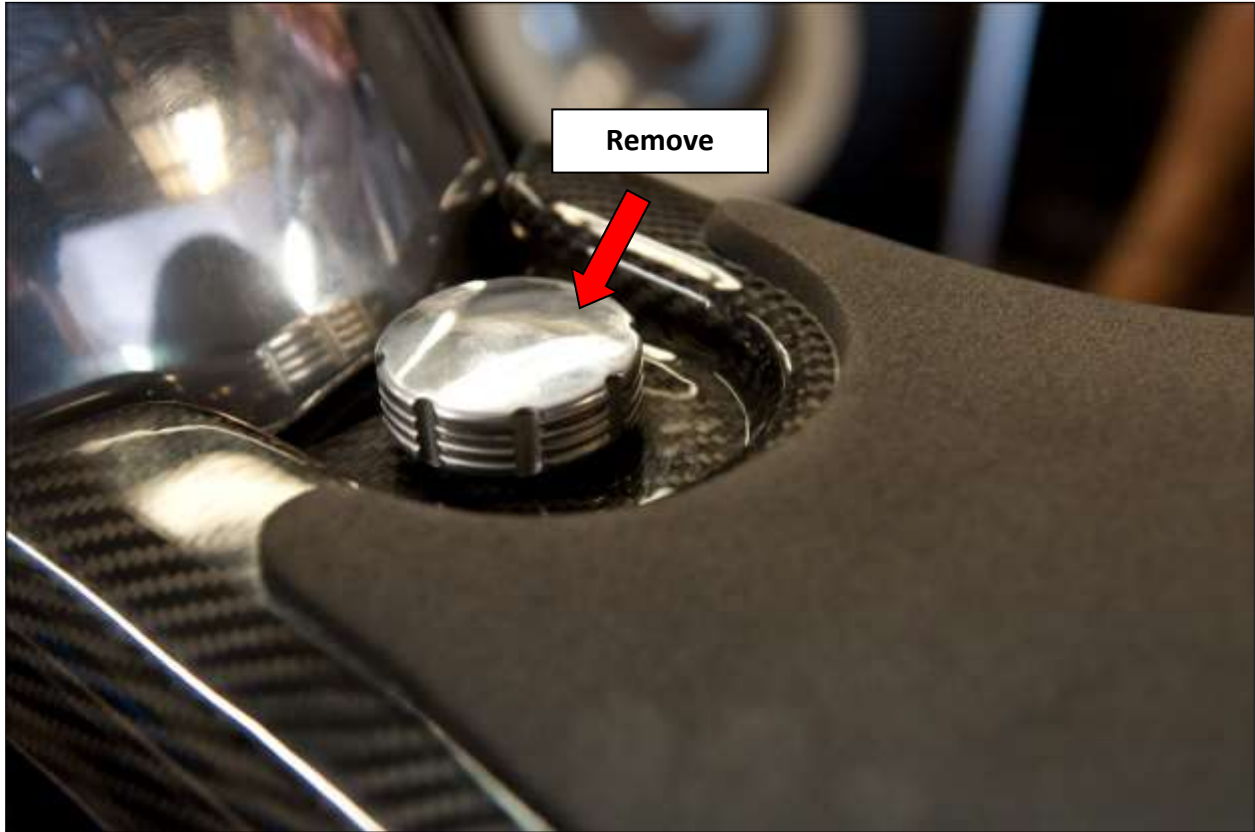




This section shows how to remove your DOMI Tail Section

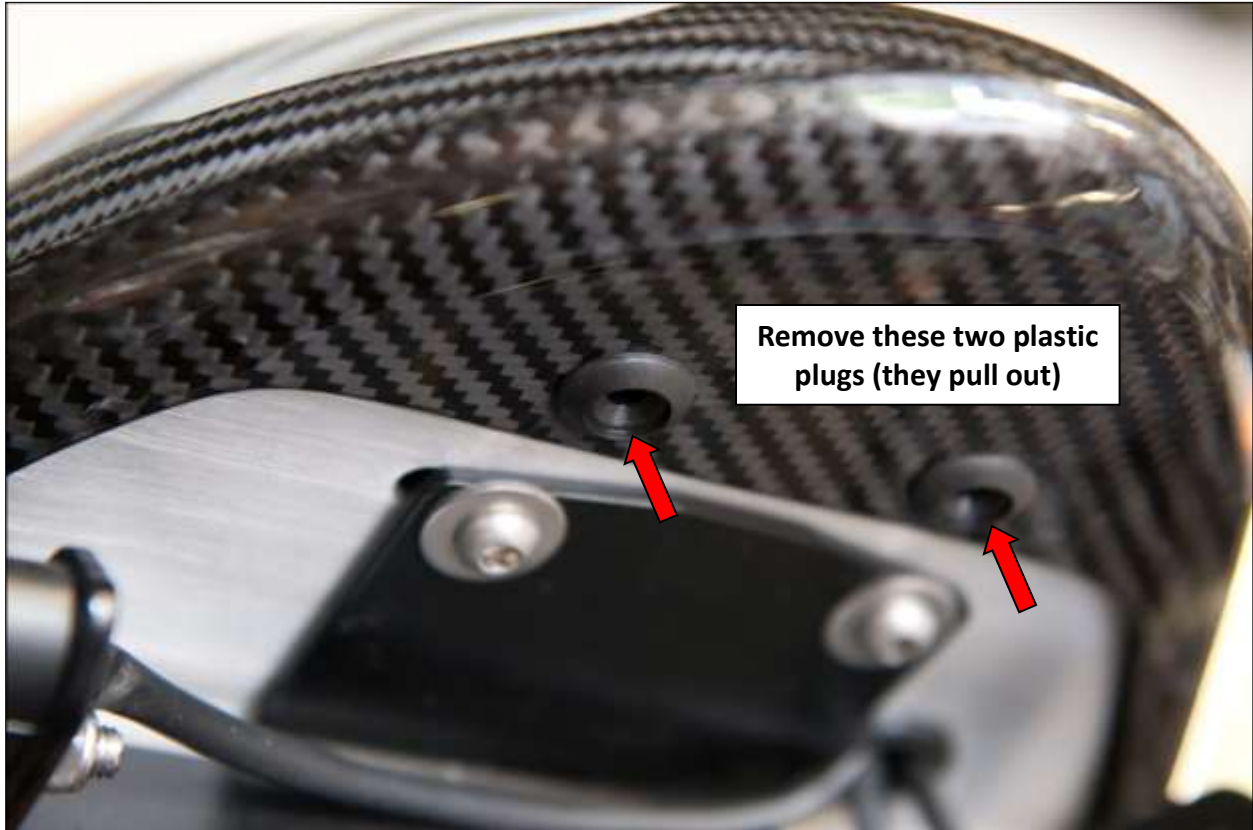
Per chance you need to re-map your ECU or replace a fuse, you will need to remove the tail section.









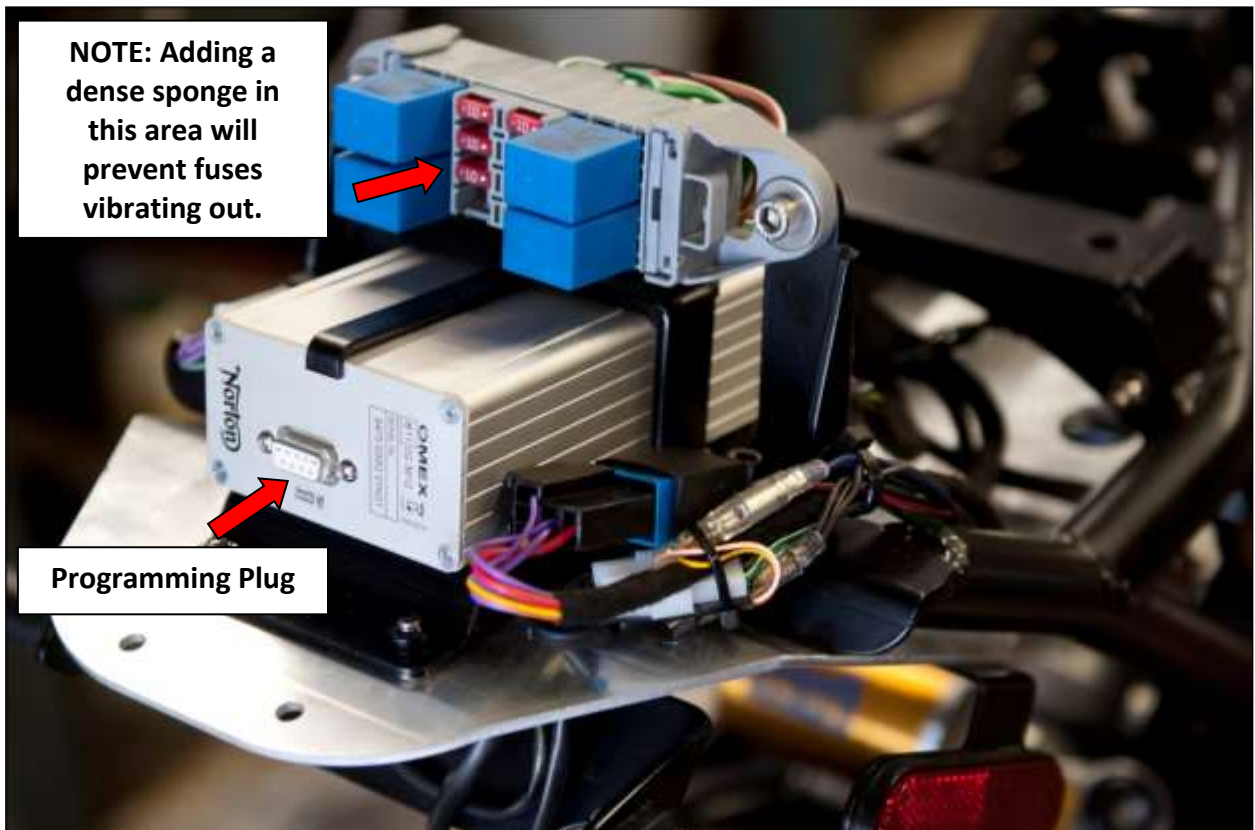


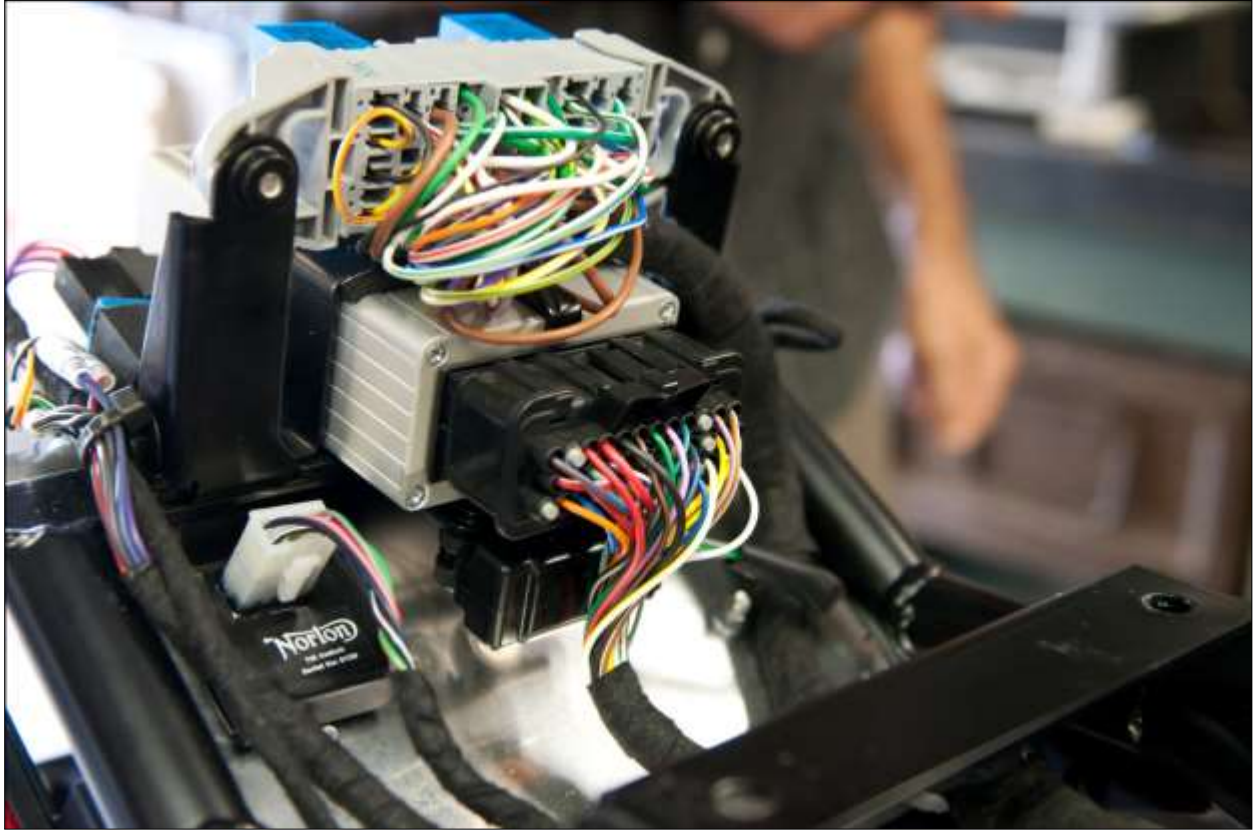
Under the seat is an aluminum plate that has two rubber grommets. Remove the Grommets and use a socket to remove one nut per hole that holds the seat to the frame.

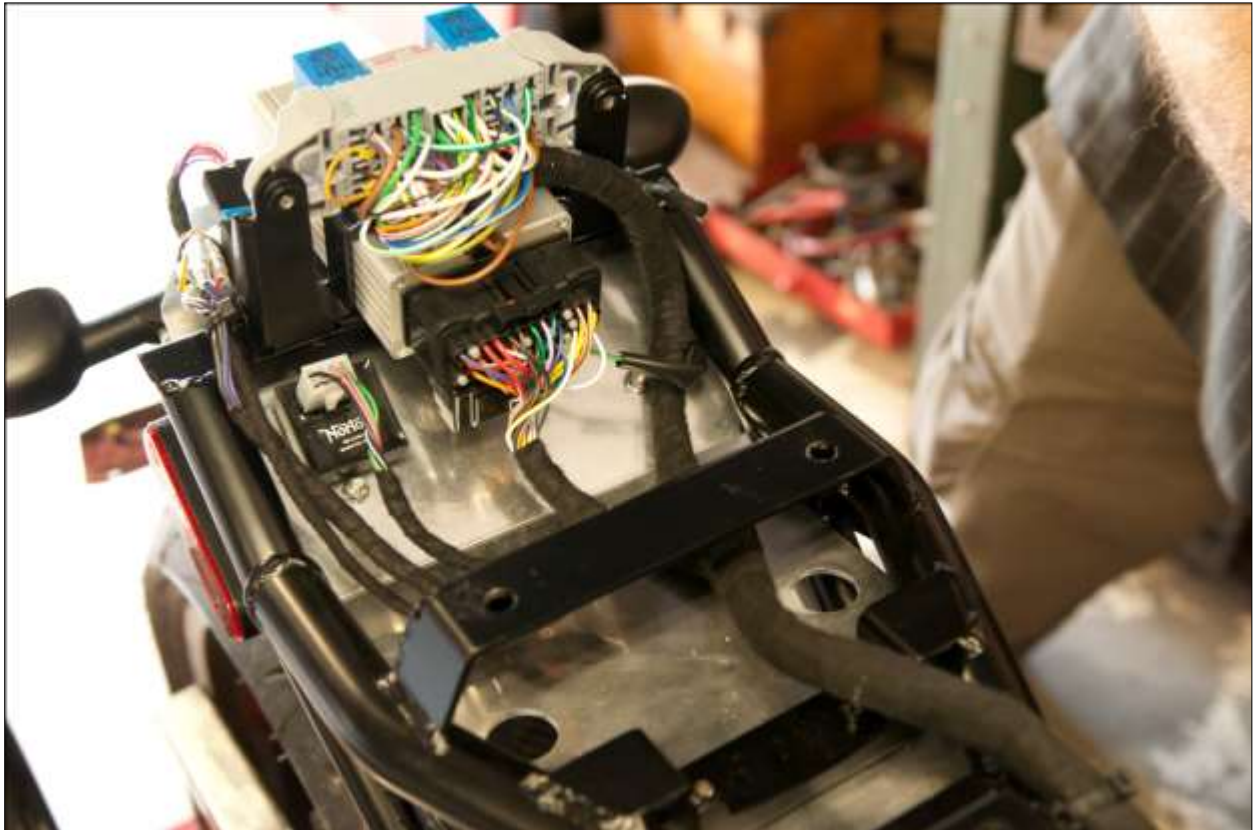
